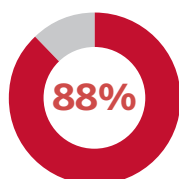

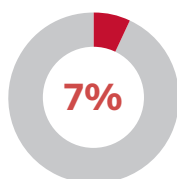

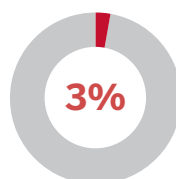

Employment statistics from 1993–2015

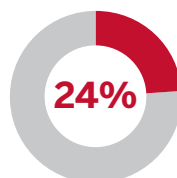
