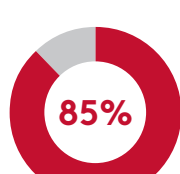

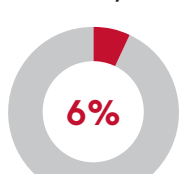

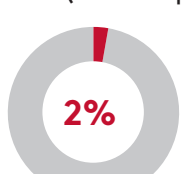
POST-GRADUATION PLANS, CLASS OF 2016 (90% response)

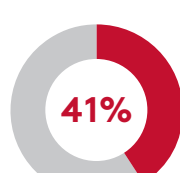

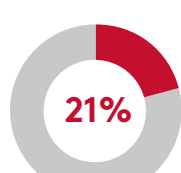

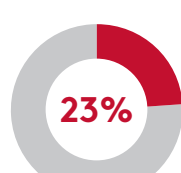
