- **A comparable course** in micro-economics

AND

- **Introductory Statistics** (AEM 2100, ILRST 2100, PAM 2100, PAM 2101, Math 1710, ENGRD 2700, CEE 304, ECON 3130, ECON 3125, PSYCH 3500, BTRY 3010, HADM 2010, STSCI 2100, OR ECON 3110-3120)

PLEASE NOTE

- **Two of the four** required courses must be taken at Cornell University.
- **Please submit a complete syllabus** to Nancy Bell at nmc52@cornell.edu. Course descriptions will not be accepted in place of a syllabus.
- To transfer financial accounting, a **proficiency test** is required. No online courses will be accepted for this requirement.
- A course is only acceptable for transfer credit if it is listed on the applicant's **college transcript**.
